

CFAES Skid Loader Safety Training Certification Form

The College of Food, Agricultural and Environmental Sciences promotes and practices safety on the farm and in the field. Operation of a skid loader must be done in a safe manner to prevent injury to the operator or pedestrians in the area; and to prevent damage to property during operation. Safe operation of a skid loader must be covered in the operator training.

Once properly instructed, the skid loader operator must assume responsibility for his or her safety on the skid loader and each skid loader operator will sign a form indicating completion of training. Employees (permanent or student), non-employee students (who operate skid loaders as a course requirement) or CFAES program participants / volunteers will receive initial training before being assigned to operate a skid loader and will complete refresher training every year.
